START OF UNAPPROVED MINUTES for the 6/8/15 Meeting. Board members present included Ray Campbell, Dave Ernst, Jim Caison, David Ruehle, Jeff Fountain, Tami Hahn, Wayne Aycock, Tom Mix, Jeffrey DeSantis, Club Members Present:: George Valsame.

President Ray Campbell called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM

Previous meeting minutes were approved as presented.

New Business:

Water line to new maintenance building. Ray requested the funds to allow for an approximately 350' water line to be run to new building to allow for wash sinks and hoses at building. Per his estimate, cost would be around \$4 per linear foot for a 1 1/4" transitioning down to 1' line of PVC pipe. Max cost would likely be around \$1750, but less if club members do labor. Tami motioned to allot \$1500 for project and David Ruehle seconded. Motion carried.

Changes to Constitution and Bylaws structure- BGC Member George Valsame gave a presentation on the need to modify our operating paperwork to more correctly reflect our status as a 501(C) 7 tax exempt organization in keeping with Chapter 55A of US tax codes.

He recommended forming a committee to condense and clarify our current docs into those which would comply with current tax laws and then present their recommendations to the BOD and have changes ready for end of year meeting and vote of approval by general membership.

Ray asked if George would be willing to chair a Legislative policy committee to meet above goals and he agreed. Ray and the EC will appoint other committee members and plan for revisions to be ready by this fall.

Old Business-

Moving Target range-work is progressing, should be done in 4 weeks or so.

Meeting adjourned at 10:10 PM.
